The UA Federal Executive Actions website is being updated daily.

As of February 10, 2025, the National Institutes of Health (NIH) has implemented a policy capping the Facilities and Administrative (F&A) rate, also known as the indirect cost rate, at 15% for all new and existing garts, effectively preventing any F&A rate increase; this represents a significant

decrease from previously negotiated rates which could be much higher for some institutions. As of this meeting 22 states have filed lawsuits against the NH.

UAFY26 Operating and Capital Budget

The Redbook has been attached above.

The budget (as outlined in the Redbook) was discussed in the House UA Subcommittee on February 10, 2025. The meeting information and President Pitney's presentation is attached.

The Governor's budget was almost 100% aligned with the University of Alaska's (UA) Board of Regents (BOR) request, particularly in terms of compensation and fixed costs.

The budget request also included funds to absorb the inflationary costs of benefits such as healthcare for UAA. Agenda and Summary are filed. The budget request is attached.
