An Mw 7.0 earthquake vigorously shook Anchorage, the largest city in the state of Alaska on November 30th, 2018. The quake was located about 14 km northwest of Anchorage, and at a depth of 41.8 km on the subducting Pacific plate, underneath the North American plate.
