Subject: Resolution on Support to Alaskan Native Student, Faculty, and Staff

**On March 19, 2021 the UAA Faculty Senate Diversity Committee approved the following resolution.**

**Resolution #210 19-1**

In December 2020 the UAA Faculty Senate Diversity Committee (FSDC) approved a motion in support of the resolution made by the Alaska Native Studies Council regarding the retention of Alaskan Native faculty and student at UAA. A December 20, 2020 endorsement from the Alaska Native Studies Council recommended the formation of a task force to develop a series of recommendations with a prioritized timeline and benchmark for implementation. FSDC supports the formation of this Task Force and would like to emphasize the importance of the following resolution:

- Without administrative accountability all effort to support our Alaskan Native unit are in danger of failing. The concern raised this year are critical due to lack of neglected finding and recommendation. We recommend that administrative objective be used with the aim of contributing to a fair balance of Alaskan Native faculty to student.
- Alaskan Native Studies need to be strengthened as a program. Resources should be invested to support the creation of an Alaskan Native major and the required number of faculty members should be hired.
- In addition to the recommendation regarding recruitment, we also recommend that a working group be formed to focus specifically on faculty retention. The information gathered from exit interview would provide useful insight into preventing future losses.
- Recruitment and retention of Alaskan Native staff as well as faculty should be pursued. Those with advanced degrees (e.g. Ph.D.) are particularly rare.

rare. In addition to the recommendation in support of unit building, we recommend that resources be focused on pipeline that encourage and allow Alaskan Native student to obtain the necessary qualification to become potential UA faculty members.
